Project Detour: 72-hour Driver Intervention Program

Project Detour begins Thursday evening and is completed Sunday evening. Dates and times will be provided by Townhall II when scheduling. A breathalyzer will be given when checking in. Any person with a number above .000 will be retested one time. If the test still does not read .000, you will not be able to check in.

What to Bring:

- Photo ID (driver's license or temporary state ID, work ID, military ID or passport)
- Clothing: casual attire (no short-shorts, crop tops or tank tops)
- Toiletries
 - Shampoo and conditioner
 - Soap
 - Deodorant
 - Toothbrush and toothpaste
 - Razor and shaving cream
 - Feminine products
- Prescribed medications: All medications must be in original containers and listed on your medication sheet.
- Over-the-counter medications: All OTC medications must be in new, sealed bottles and listed on your medication sheet.
 - Medications will be locked in a case. You will have access to them as needed.
- Down time materials: Reading, coloring and journaling materials. You will not have access to your cell phone.
- Snacks: All snack items must be new and unopened. There is a mini fridge and microwave in each room.
 - Meals will be provided Friday morning through Sunday afternoon. If you have any special dietary needs, please let Townhall II staff know when you register.
- Money for vending machines (cold beverages and snacks).
- Cigarettes, lighters, chew and vapes are permitted, but will be held by staff and given out during breaks.

Items not Permitted:

- Electronics:
 - Cell phones
 - Laptops
 - Tablets, iPads
 - Kindles or Nooks
 - Gaming systems
 - Smart watches
- Alcohol, illegal drugs or paraphernalia.
- Pornographic materials.
- Mouthwash, cologne, aftershave, perfume or aerosol cans. Be mindful of other people's allergies.
- Weapons of any kind (knives, guns, etc.).
- Valuables. We are not responsible for any losses.
