

Our New Ravenna Office

On June 12, 2024, Townhall II Integrated Health Network celebrated the opening of our new office in Ravenna, Ohio, with a ribbon cutting event attended by staff, sister agencies, community supporters and the media.

The office, located at 520 N. Chestnut St., will house the agency's growing Prevention Department, and additional services, as we anticipate duplicating the services offered at our downtown Kent facility. Sunshine Cupcakes and Murray's Munchies, both of Ravenna, were kind enough to provide food for the event.

What Has Prevention Been Up To?

The 2023-2024 school year came with requirements through several Ohio laws. These laws require instruction on suicide awareness and prevention, safety training and violence prevention, as well as substance abuse prevention and social inclusion in the classroom. Specifically, Erin's Law requires curriculum for child sexual abuse prevention, dating violence prevention, and sexual violence prevention. The laws include requirements for classroom instruction, parent/legal guardian awareness as well as notification and training for school personnel. Townhall II's robust Prevention team has been providing instruction in child sexual abuse prevention, teen dating violence prevention, substance abuse prevention and suicide awareness and prevention for many years. Our curriculum also includes training for school personnel and parents/guardians in all topics, so we were ready to hit the ground running.

Our Portage County school districts have been amazing! We are so proud to say that all districts have been utilizing our programming for over 20 years and have been ahead of the game in numerous ways. The Mental Health and Recovery Board of Portage County has been a strong champion of prevention and is one of the biggest reasons Townhall II can provide substance abuse prevention and teen dating violence programming in Portage County free of charge. Grant assistance from the Rape Crisis Fund and The Ohio Department of Health assists us in providing Personal Body Safety (child violence prevention programming), Stand Up (teen dating violence curriculum adapted from Safe Dates), Signs of Suicide, and Start with Hello in the schools free of charge. This year, our prevention services also reached Mogadore City Schools, Nordonia City Schools, and Twinsburg City Schools.

Through our prevention services, we also provide school districts, juvenile court, and Kent State University with online education courses. Additionally, we provide several parent education programs through grants from the Ohio Children's Trust Fund and the Department of Youth Services. The United Way of Portage County and The Ohio Department of Health help fund our annual youth summit and youth led prevention projects as well.

Townhall II's Prevention Team would like to thank all of Portage County's School Districts (Field, Rootstown, Southeast, Ravenna, Kent, Garrettsville, Windham, Streetsboro, Aurora, Crestwood, and Waterloo), as well as Bio-Med and the Kent, Ravenna, Streetsboro and Atwater Head Start, for inviting us into their classrooms every year. It is a joy to work with you and your students and we thank you for your support!

We also thank Twinsburg, Nordonia and Mogadore School Districts for the chance to serve your classrooms this year. We look forward to many more years with your students!
