Post-traumatic Stress Disorder Awareness Month

Trauma has a major impact on our society.

Many of the problems we see, including addiction, suicides, self-injurious behaviors, and codependent relationships often have their roots in disturbing events from the past. If people don't address trauma issues they are unlikely to make much progress in the problems that stem from it.

It is important to define trauma because people have a lot of different ideas about what that word means. Trauma is an upsetting loss of control over one's life and/or body that goes on to have an impact on current functioning. It is also important to note that everyone experiences trauma different.

Crestwood Students Learn Emotional Regulation though Townhall II Groups

Townhall II collaborated with Crestwood Local Schools to develop and facilitate an eight-week group focusing on emotional regulation and developing coping skills. Emotional regulation is one's ability to control their own emotions and either increasing the positive or decreasing the negative ones. The students were educated on how to notice what they were feeling, validate that feeling, practice grounding techniques to assist them in focusing on the details of their surroundings, identify and reduce triggers, make the connection between emotions & physical symptoms, and learn the several types of communication as well as active listening skills. The students in the groups were in grades K-4 and 7-12. Group members were encouraged to openly share experiences and problem solving while in the group. These discussions and experiences were then used to develop appropriate emotional responses that can be used in school, at home, and out in the community.

Townhall II and Crestwood Locals School have been working together for several years providing substance abuse prevention and sexual assault prevention programming. We were excited to pilot this new program with the Crestwood students as well to foster a community that educates, supports, and empowers the youth.
